Tips for Illustrating Book Pages

Before you draw:

- 🌀 Choose interesting scenes from your story to illustrate. Think—

What are the most important events?

When do my characters show a lot of action or feelings?

- 🌀 Vary your pictures. Think—

When do I need to share an important detail or a character's feeling?
(Show these scenes up close.)

When do I need to show characters in action? When is a change in the
setting important? (Show these scenes a little farther away.)

- 🌀 Match details from your story in your illustrations.



After you have your plan:

- 🌀 Draw your pictures in pencil.
- 🌀 Use washable markers to fill in your drawings.

Use one color at a time.

Let the ink dry before moving to the next marker so the colors don't smear.
