



Complete your project

Pack key items back into your envelope:

- Include all signed parent order forms - even those marked "no" along with any payments received in the orange, Payment Envelope.
- Include your printed **Order Confirmation Page** from Studentreasures.com/Finalize.
- Organize your cover sheet, title and dedication pages, along with your book pages in numbered order, then your authors page. This will always be the last page of your book.
- Fill out the white box marked with a star on the flap of your kit envelope.
- One week before your publishing date:
 - Pack all your materials in the box they arrived in and securely tape all sides shut.
 - Use the pre-paid UPS label included in your kit to completely cover the previous label.
 - Make the box available to the UPS driver for pickup.
